

Erik Lagerweij appointed Managing Director of Lelystad Airport

The Board of Management of Schiphol Group has appointed Erik Lagerweij (54) as the new Managing Director of Lelystad Airport as of 1 February 2011. Erik Lagerweij will succeed Lex Oude Weernink, who held the position since 2004.

Erik Lagerweij has worked for Schiphol Group since 1987. Currently he is Senior Corporate Responsibility Officer. Previously he held various advisory and management positions at the airport.

In his new position, Erik Lagerweij will focus to a large extent on implementing the development of Lelystad Airport as envisaged in the Alders Agreement.

As of the same date, Lex Oude Weernink will take up the position of Senior Programme Manager at Schiphol College, which is a joint initiative of Schiphol Group and the Regional Training Centre (ROC) of Amsterdam. He will combine this role with an intended part-time lectorate at Inholland University of Applied Sciences, which is launching a new Bachelor's programme in Airport and Aviation Management in the spring of 2011.

The new lectorate forms part of a covenant recently concluded between Schiphol Group and Inholland University of Applied Sciences setting out the details of their collaboration. With activities focusing on the interface between the labour market, education and the business sector, Schiphol College has enjoyed enormous success since its foundation at Amsterdam Airport Schiphol in 2007.
