Schiphol constructs, converts and connects

This will involve an average daily investment of 1.5 million euros, 7 days a week, 365 days a year, for the duration of 2014, 2015 and 2016. This far-reaching renovation effort will increase capacity, allowing Schiphol to offer greater comfort with more spacious terminals and piers, and more smoothly coordinated passenger processes.
